Pallet racking installations in New Zealand now require a building consent. We can complete your consent, including the documentation needed to ensure the installation will comply with the New Zealand Building Code.

Things to consider:

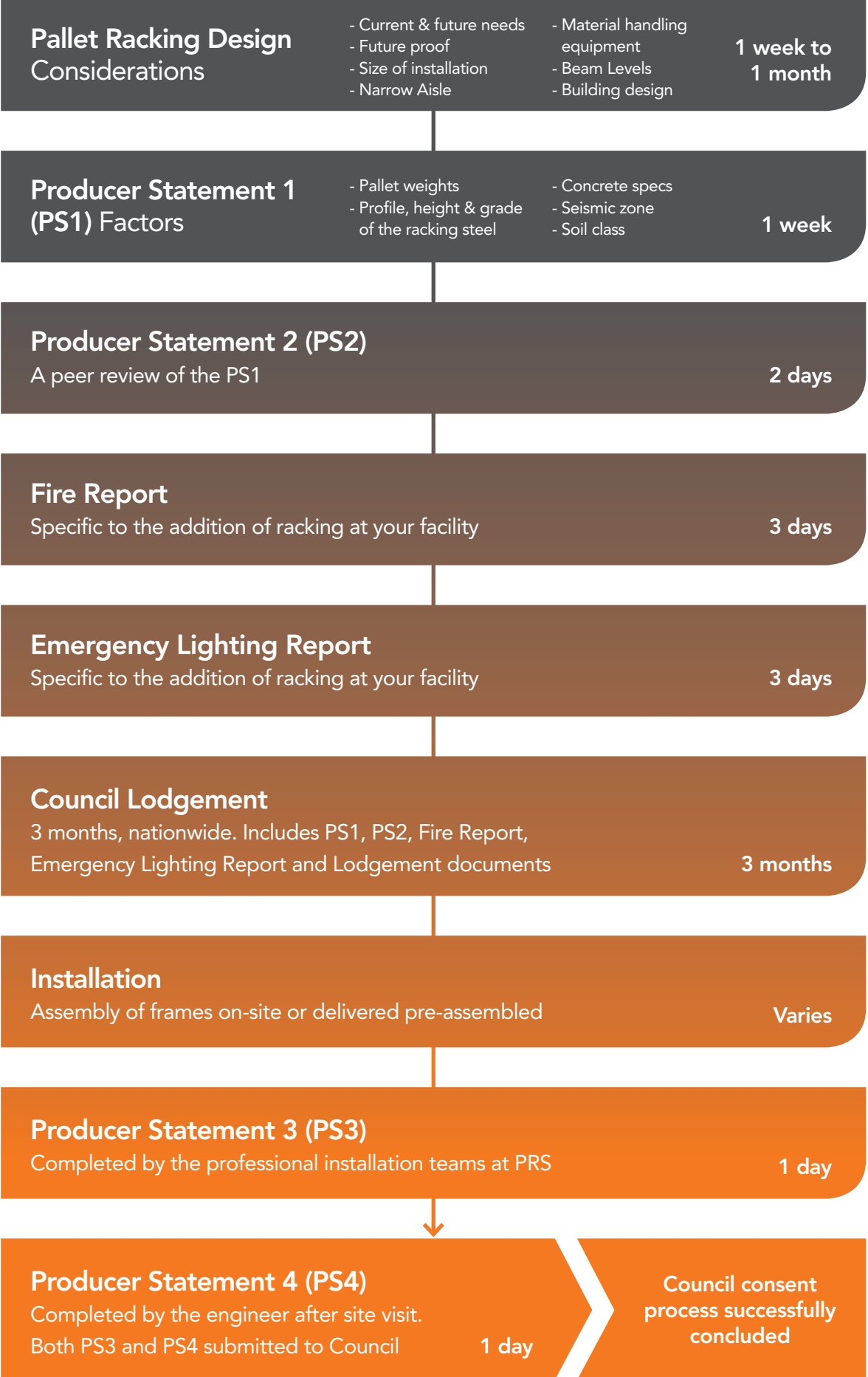
- What's the right type of racking for your needs? Consider your soil class, concrete floor specifications, seismic zone, the structural integrity of your chosen racking, and loading weights on beams/frames.
- Don't forget to check out the above before you sign a lease or purchase a property – the state of the building will have significant implications for your racking.
- Safety comes first, but design and planning are also key to maximising usable storage space and efficiency in warehouses with challenging dimensions.
- Greater profile components are required if your warehouse is in a challenging seismic zone. This may extend to seismic bracing.
- Fire Safety Reports and Emergency Lighting Reports also need to be completed as part of your warehouse building consent application.
- Your Fire and Emergency Lighting Reports need to be specific to the racking and your stock. e.g. paper or other flammable products may require an in-rack sprinkler system.
- Look for a pallet racking specialist that offers consenting as part of an overall service.
- Most importantly, get some expert advice: it will save you time and money in the long run, and keep you on the right side of the law (and your insurer).

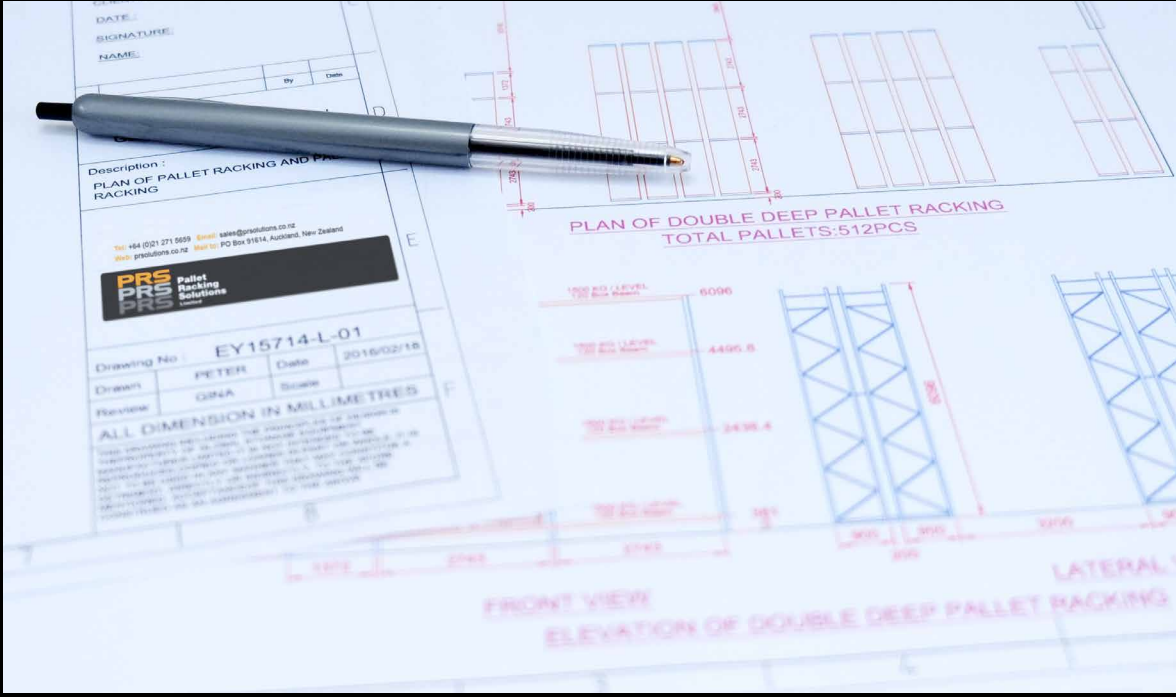
